March 2020

Destination Greater Victoria and the Greater Victoria Tourism Rescue and Recovery Task Force (Task Force), comprised of twelve tourism business leaders from the hotel, transportation, and attraction sectors, as well as destination marketing organizations, have been working hard to advocate for industry support from government. The Task Force has prioritized five requests for government that are critical to support tourism businesses immediately and going forward, including:

- Extending the Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy (CEWS) well into 2021.
- Extending the 16-week period before severance is required for staff on temporary layoff, as well as flexibility on group lay-off provisions for tourism's highly seasonal workforce.
- Interest-free loans, grants, subsidies, or similar financial supports.
- Support for COVID-19 safety oriented and physical social-distancing measures.
- Redirect Destination Canada and Destination BC marketing funds from traditional international source markets to domestic source markets at the community level for the short term upon approved restart.

These priorities will be updated as recovery takes place and more clarity is gained around the support that tourism businesses require in order to survive.
