## **April 2021**

- The travel and accommodation sectors were impacted heavily due to circuit breaker restrictions in April which introduced some the most severe restrictions since the pandemic commenced. Included in these restrictions was a ban on travel between British Columbia's health regions.
- The industry was very pleased to see the BC Restart Plan announced in May.
- To monitor British Columbian's current views on travel and tourism as well as track travel and tourism behaviour intentions, Destination BC has commissioned biweekly waves of research, starting May 13, 2020 to track opinions and intentions in the context of COVID-19. To view reports, click here.
