
- Results on key metrics for Greater Victoria's commercial accommodation sector continued to be positive during
 most of December 2021, approaching pre-pandemic levels in many categories. However, momentum decreased
 when further restrictions were introduced to address increasing COVID cases due to the Omicron variant.
- Overall, with re-opening and gradual recovery in the accommodation sector over the latter half of 2021, business
 results were much improved compared to 2020. Greater Victoria also performed strongly compared to other
 regions in BC. However, tourism businesses outside of the accommodation sector remain severely impacted
 by the pandemic and access to all markets and channels of business continues to be needed for significant and
 sustained recovery.
- Despite interruptions to business due to the Omicron variant, Destination Greater Victoria remains positive in it's outlook for business in 2022 and is positioned to market the destination strongly in all channels as soon as conditions allow.
