- Dine Around and Stay in Town was very successful in 2021, thanks to our restaurants and hotels who
 operated safely and proved how seriously governments and restaurants took their safety protocols.
- Overall in January, operators continued to suffer under travel restrictions.
- The Victoria Conference Centre remains closed due to restrictions on public gatherings, however the City of Victoria is using this time to upgrade the finishes of the facility including fresh paint, floor tiling and other improvements.
- A strong public sector and consistently low cases of COVID-19 helped Vancouver Island place six communities in the Top 10 Most Resilient Cities in BC, according to BC Business Magazine.
