



## VICTORIA TOURISM BULLETIN

## **July 2021**

- The pace of reservations increased steadily in July with Phase 3 of the BC Restart Plan.
- Destination Greater Victoria's Reconnect 2.0 Campaign resonated well with domestic Canadian travellers, driving strong visitation and metrics.
- Despite increased summer business, throughout July Greater Victoria's visitor economy continued to be impacted by lack of access to key source markets and channels of business, including US visitors, meetings and conventions, sports events and continuing closure of the marine border for international ferries.
