- From the outset of the pandemic, the Hotel Association Canada's (HAC) objective has been to deliver the maximum level of financial support to hotels from government and to enable the quickest possible return to normal operations. As expected, the government has shifted gears with the 2021 Budget away from relief and more towards recovery.
