- Victoria, B.C. was selected as a Good Housekeeping 2024 Family Travel Awards winner.
- The Canadian Football League (CFL), the BC Lions and the City of Victoria announced the first Touchdown Pacific will be held in the city in late summer 2024.
- Destination Greater Victoria relaunched the Victoria Hospitality Awards with the support of the Hotel Association of Greater Victoria, Attractions Victoria and the City of Victoria. November winners were Jason Thorne from Chateau Victoria Hotel & Suites and Lynn Jordan from Days Inn Victoria on the Harbour.
- Helijet announced it is on track to become the first Canadian air carrier to provide passenger and cargo services using electric vertical takeoff and landing (eVTOL) aircraft.
